The embellishment and upgrading of Triton Square and the restoration of the Triton Fountain were intended to satisfy a list of objectives such as converting the square into a free urban central meeting point for social, cultural and entertainment activities and events,



restoring the Triton Fountain to its original appearance and function as the focal point of the square, reviving the historical backdrop of the square while preserving the archaeological findings, rendering the square as a pedestrian area accessible for all from the Biskuttin to City Gate, and facilitating the operational requirements in and around the square in an organised and safe way.



The Conservatory of Music is at the heart of a much broader public project. It serves as a catalyst for a refined ur-

ban lifestyle, breathing new life into the entire public pedestrian space. The use of massive stone in the construction is a striking environmental performance. With little transformation at a nearby source, it makes for a low carbon footprint. The first choice is the superposition of the programmeme over three levels. The space thus freed makes it possible to keep the existing trees and create a central void, conceived as a third amenity between the media centre and the conservatory. In its relationship with the site, the conservatory offers a first response to this contradictory demand that consists of creating a facility that is both a bold symbol of public renewal and a discrete element of the historic residential fabric.
